

Visas for Pre-MEd TESOL

You will need a special visa for Pre-MEd TESOL.

Students should apply for a 6-month student visa in the first instance. Include in your visa application your MEd TESOL conditional offer letter so that the Visa Office can see that you intend to stay a year and a half.

Whether you are a visa national or a non-visa national, the procedure for applying for entry to the UK is the same. You should contact your local British Embassy or High Commission in the country in which you are living. There is a charge for visas and for entry clearance. To make an application, you will have to produce the following items:

1. The completed form
2. A valid passport
3. Two recent passport-sized photographs
4. The fee
5. Your conditional offer letter from the University of Edinburgh stating that you have been accepted on to a full-time course which sets out the structure of the course with start and end dates.
6. Evidence of adequate funding to meet the cost of your course fees and living expenses
7. Evidence of any sponsorship/funding you have for the course

When you get to Edinburgh, you take Pre-MEd TESOL Modules 4 and 5. When you have been formally advised by that you have passed Pre-MEd TESOL and that you have been accepted on to the MEd TESOL, you apply for a year extension to your visa. To do this, you see Ann McKay in the International Office, George Square, from 10am -12noon Monday to Friday.
